

2016 Spring Gobbler Harvest Report

The 2016 spring gobbler season harvest for Fort A.P. Hill (FAPH) totaled 49. This year's harvest was a 37.2% decrease below the 2015 spring gobbler season. Weights increased slightly from 19.05 lbs last season to 19.21 lbs. this season. The average beard length showed a slight decrease in length from 9.21 inches last year to 9.18 this season. Average spur length increased from the 2015 season at .930 inches to this season at .995 inches. The heaviest gobbler harvested on FAPH this past season was 23 lbs. 4 oz. One bird taken out of TA 15 had four beards which totaled 37.75inches of beard! The top training areas were TA 15 and TA 25 with a harvest of 4 and the top controlled area was CA 20 with a harvest of 3.
