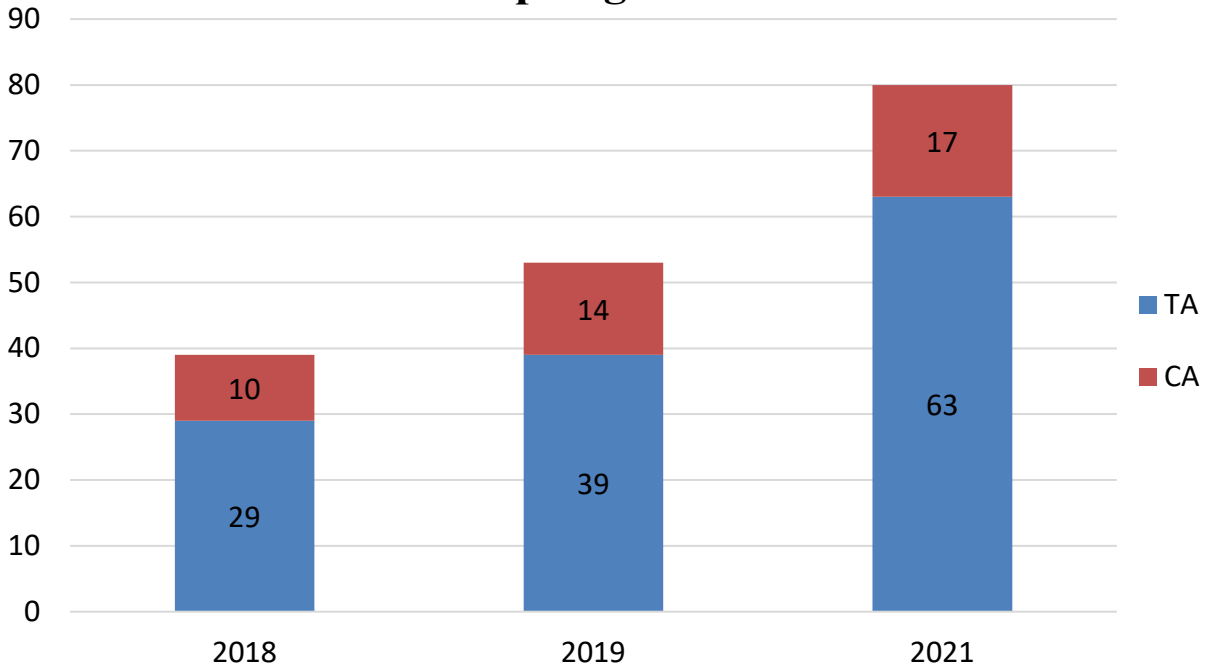


2021 Spring Gobbler Harvest Report

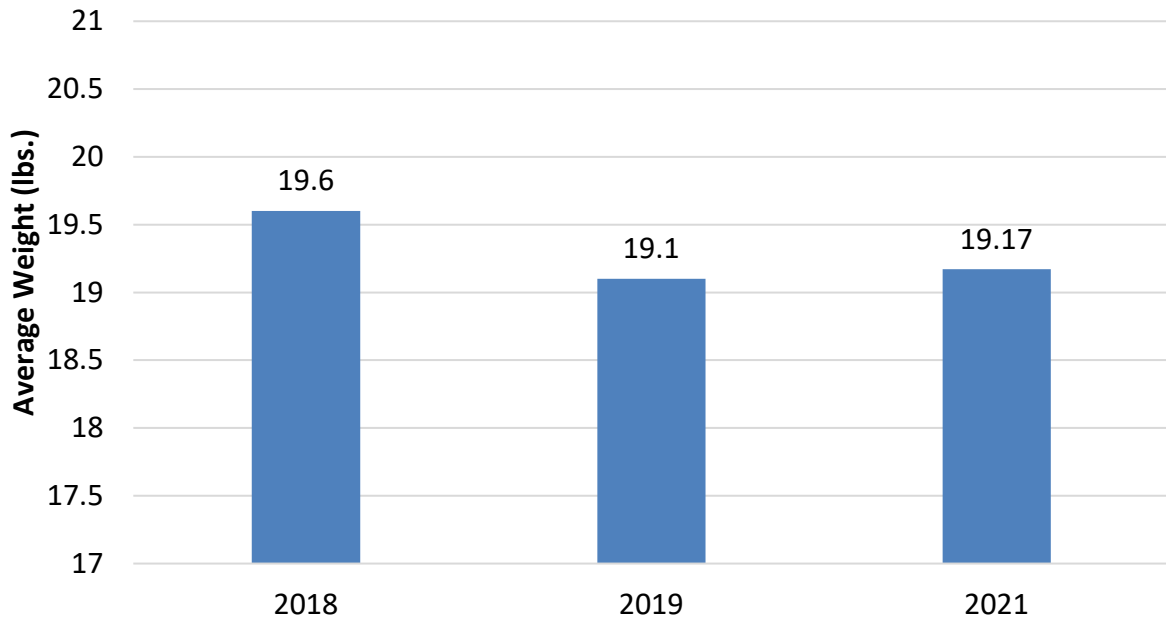
The 2021 spring gobbler season harvest for Fort A.P. Hill (FAPH) totaled 80. This year's harvest was a 51 percent increase from the 2019 spring gobbler season. Weights increased slightly from last season at an average of 19.17 lbs. The average beard length showed an increase in length from 9.61 inches last year to 9.9 this season. Average spur length decreased from the 2019 season at 1.02 inches to this season at .94 inches. The top training area was TA 28 with a harvest of 9 and the top controlled area was CA 14 with a harvest of 3.
